Update: Assembly Bill 531 (July 16, 1997) signed by the Governor includes definitions of geology and professional geologists. It also requires the Director of the Nevada Bureau of Mines and Geology to be a professional geologist. Language that addressed reports prepared by engineering geologists became controversial with civil engineers and was deleted. For UST and hazardous waste projects, certification based on education and experience is required, but that exists as an agency certification rule and not by statute.
