**Requirements:**

Education: Degree in geology or related science, or completion of 30 semester hours leading to a major, of which 24 hours are in upper level undergraduate or graduate courses

Experience: Five years, with at least three years under the supervision of a licensed geologist or three cumulative years of responsible charge work. Credit for undergraduate and graduate work cannot exceed four years of the five year experience requirement.
